Shawiya Berber people

Pray for the teams living and serving among Turks, especially those working in areas where it is dangerous to share Christianity openly. Student revival for Christ in universities

More than 3,000 students, graduates and staff met in Germany for the IFES Europe student evangelism conference, Revive, in December 2019. Delegates came from 38 European countries as well as Africa, Asia, and closed countries. It began with a dream of seeing a generation come together from every corner of Europe to pursue revival in the university world and beyond. More than 20 other Christian student ministries in Europe partnered with IFES Europe in dreaming, planning and praying. A recently renovated disused post office building houses The Patchwork Center in Schwerin. It is multi-functional and includes a community café, workshop space, music and function rooms. The café and workshop space are managed with the help of local people. The European Christian Mission (ECM) team aims to bring people closer to the gospel through its diverse activities, where everyone is welcome, where anyone can participate and where everyone can encounter Jesus at their own pace. Please pray for one man: his body is full of tattoos which express how many bad things have happened in his life. Christian lawyers conference in Germany

Recently, over 200 Christian lawyers drawn from across Europe (and a few from further afield) gathered in Berlin to deepen their knowledge of God, build relationships with one another and to be strengthened to be salt and light in their communities. Many came alone, knowing only a few, and for some not even one, other Christian lawyers in their community or country. Please pray that each of these delegates would return home with a fresh vision of God's heart for justice and their call to serve him in their church, community and legal institutions. Reaching Kurds through technology

Recently a Kurdish refugee couple in Rostock started to come to church and brought other Kurds living in the same refugee centre with them. ECM worker Klaus started to translate the sermons into English which were then translated into Kurdish, but it was noisy at the back, so they wished for the miracle of Pentecost! But then, Klaus found a computer app, and in the service he now sits and types what is said, or phrases from the songs, and the refugee friends can read it translated into their language on their smartphones, almost like watching a film with subtitles! Praise God for the technology to break through language barriers, and ask that more Kurds would come to Christ through the church in Germany. (European Christian Mission - September 2018)

Prison ministry in Germany

In eastern Germany, communism and, after that, economic difficulties, have left deep marks in the spiritual lives of the people. The Christian faith has been pushed to the margins of society. In the southwest of the country there are a large number of refugees, with several religious backgrounds, trying to build new lives. Pray that while supporting them in tackling the difficulties in their lives, we will help them to find a new life in the gospel that transcends all cultural differences.
