

Family Remote Debriefing consent form

For ethical and legal issues, we ask parents for a written and signed authorization to debrief with the children on an individual basis if requested and desired - whether the debriefing takes place face-to-face or at a distance (remote-debriefing).

For safety reason, we also ask that a trusted person be named and present in the room during the session with the child. It can be one of the parents if agreed by the child. This person does not intervene and must abide by the terms of confidentiality.
